

HATFIELD INDOOR BOWLS CLUB 11-09-20

Players rules winter 2020-2021

The club has available 3 rinks of triples. Roll up sessions must be booked online (or by phone: 07939 024013). Leagues will be automatically booked on a new sessions chart.

Roll up bowling can start from 5th October and the leagues starting from Monday 19th October

Players should enter the club with a suitable face covering (nose & mouth)

USE HAND SANITIZER IN THE LOBBY when entering or exiting and also other dispensers which are sited around the club.

Two metre social distancing must be observed AT ALL TIMES, the club is suitably marked out with 2 metre distancing.

Players can, when SEATED in the lounge, remove their masks, but when moving around in circulation areas a mask must be worn (Government mandatory instructions 23-09-20)

If only ONE METRE DISTANCE is possible WHEN IN THE CLUB or WHEN BOWLING, then the face masks must be worn at all times

Players must arrive ready to bowl,

The changing rooms are not available, except for access to the lockers to collect bowls, but no more than 3 PLAYERS are allowed in at any one time. Provision for changing shoes will be available in the lounge area, where outdoor clothes must be left.

Changing room toilets are CLOSED, please ONLY USE THE TOILETS IN THE INDOOR GREEN and observe the instructions on usage.

Bowling sessions are TWO AND A HALF HOURS (or less) do not overrun your allotted time.

Between sessions there is a half hour space to allow one set of players to leave and the next session to arrive i.e. 15 minutes for both sessions.

Do NOT enter the green until your allotted time you must not enter and sit down and talk to those already playing.

Care must be taken when entering and leaving the rinks, observe a "one in – one out " system.

Keep to your allotted rink, DO NOT interact with other rinks (EIBA instruction 23-09-20)

If possible, use 2 jacks and mats, one for each team, only ONE PLAYER in each team to touch these. Please sanitise before and after each session. Make sure that after sanitising that the mats are dry before they are placed on the carpet. EIBA recommend that in areas such as our scoreboard end, that the mat / jack is placed at 3 metres.

Do not use the electronic scoreboard. For track and trace purposes ONLY USE SCORE CARDS with the FULL name of all players, place the cards in the box provided before leaving the green.

The drinks machine is switched off. The water machine is ok to use. If you need hot drinks, please bring your own flask.

The toilets in the green are ok to use, please observe the signage.

The rink fee system for roll ups and leagues, is the same @ £1 per person per hour, (ie: £2.50 per session) place the money in an envelope and put into the indoor green brass letter box.
