
Geoff writes:

"Walking to the stadium from White Hart Lane station was exciting as this amazing stadium became clearly visible. The crowd was large and were clearly anticipating excitement for the match.

The match started at 20.00 and the welcome Conte received was amazing. Spurs failed to disappoint. Every part of their play was on view. Spurs played with passion and were 3 up in less than 30 minutes and it could have been more. Then the other side of Spurs showed. They were hauled back to 3 – 2 before halftime. In the second half it looked ominous as Spurs failed to take control. It was not until the 85th minute when the Vitesse captain was given a second yellow card for manhandling Harry that things changed, this was followed shortly after by the goalkeeper being given a straight red.. Thankfully there was no VAR as it would have been likely the keeper would have remained. Conte found with this one game that he has a lot to resolve.

I can confirm this is a fantastic stadium and probably the best I have visited. The noise made by the crowd reverberated all around so the atmosphere was unbelievable.
