The County had cancelled the usual Men's and Ladies Annual Prize Giving Dinner and Lunch for 2021 due to COVID. They have now announced that these are to be replaced with a luncheon on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> March at the Homestead Court Hotel, Welwyn Garden City, 12.45 for 13.30.

This will be a three course lunch @£30 per head.

I will then complete the details and forward to the County.

This year's outdoor season will start on Saturday 9th April with a Club Event. Our first match will be on Sunday 24th April when we play 5 mixed rinks at Sawbridgeworth. As per last season, Ladies Captain Sue Winship will captain the Saturday matches and as Men's Captain I will captain the Sunday fixtures. We have a full programme of both friendly and competitive games this year for which Sue and I ask for your full support.

To prepare the green in advance of the opening day (clear & prepare ditches, put out the benches, tidy grounds etc.) we are holding a Grounds Maintenance Working Party on Monday 28th March 10-00am to 12noon. Free bacon rolls will be served to all helpers, so please come along, many hands make light work.

To help with catering please let me know you are coming and would like a roll by Friday 25th March. My contact details are below, emails are good. Club Events will start at 2-30pm, but we require your attendance by 2-10pm. Everyone who reports by this time will play. We need you to arrive promptly to allow us to organise the rinks to start play at 2-30pm. There is no need to book in advance for these events, although it is helpful if you could indicate your intention to play on the on-line Availability Sheet.

Many clubs coming to Hatfield at weekends this year have asked for tea, biscuits & cake and not a meal. Our ladies have offered to prepare this for us, but it would be unfair to expect them to do the washing up afterwards on every occasion as well. Therefore, a draw will be made at each game amongst leads, number 2s, 3s and skips to decide who will do this. We ask for your cooperation please, I am sure you will understand. Cost of matches with tea, biscuits & cake will be £2 and £5.50 for a meal payable by both Hatfield members and visitors. We will continue to use the on-line availability sheets and as has been practice indoors ask you to confirm your availability once selected. If you are no longer available, please enter "NA" against your name and let the captain know as soon as you can, but please do not delete your name once entered.
